Enter your name, address, email address, and how you learned about the Elks academic scholarships. By entering this information, you will be able to access and save the scholarship application.

Note the deadline for submitting your online national scholarship application is **November ¹⁴~~25~~, 2022.**

*** In addition to competing for the National Elks Scholarships, **the Northland Elks Lodge** located in Gladstone (directly behind Margaritas restaurant on North Oak) **will be awarding the additional scholarships to Northland high school seniors:**

1 - \$4,000 Scholarship (\$1,000 per year for 4 years)

4 - \$1,000 Scholarships

Important Read!

*** **To be considered for one of the above 5 scholarships, you must print and deliver a copy of your completed national scholarship application and copies of supporting artifacts to the Northland Elks Lodge #2376 at 7010 North Cherry in Gladstone, or mail the application to the following address: 7010 North Cherry, Gladstone, MO 64118. We must receive your completed application by Friday, November 25th.**

I provide the following advice for all scholarship applicants: proof read entries on the application; check for spelling and good grammar; *include as artifacts copies (not originals) of all certificates received in high school related to extra-curricular activities and academic honors and awards*; and finally, do not procrastinate in completing the application. This is a wonderful opportunity to possibly offset a portion of the expenses related to your college education.

Items to include in your scholarship packet:

- * Listing of all community service or volunteer service conducted through your high school years;
- * Certificates of Honors, awards, and certificates of participation presented to you through school or other organizations;
- * Involvement in activities where you demonstrated leadership;
- * May not be required for this year's application - ACT or SAT scores;
- * **Counselor's Report – you must ask the counselor to copy this document for you;** and
- * *A well-written essay related to your involvement in an organization and how it influenced you and your plans for the future (in college and after graduation) – use good grammar and word choice*

In years past, to be able to award the Local Scholarships from the Gladstone Elks Lodge – we required students to drop off completed applications to the Elks Lodge at 7010 North Cherry. **Once the application is completed**, I believe the following will work: 1) open a new Word document; and 2) attempt to cut and paste onto the new Word document each section of the scholarship applications and then Print. **OR**, 1) after each section is completed, attempt to "Print the Screen" and paste to a new Word document; 2) crop to remove excess information and Print the page.
