A+ Schools Program Agreement – Staley High School

Students who meet the criteria listed below may be eligible to have tuition and general fees paid to any Missouri public community college or career-technical school. Funding for the Student Financial Incentives portion of the A+ Schools Program is the sole responsibility of the State of Missouri. **The A+ Schools Program may provide these educational incentives subject legislative approval.** Funds become available semester following the student’s graduation.

The following criteria must all be met for student eligibility in the A+ Student Financial Incentive Program:

- 1. Attend an A+ designated school for three consecutive years prior to graduation;**
- 2. Have at least a 95% attendance record for the four year period;**
- 3. Graduate with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4 point scale;**
- 4. Perform fifty (50) hours of unpaid academic tutoring which is connected to North Kansas City Schools and supervised by a district employee;**
- 5. Maintain a record of good citizenship and avoidance of unlawful use of alcohol or drugs or acts of violence;**
- 6. Beginning with senior class of 2015, have achieved a score of proficient or advanced on the official Algebra I end of course exam, or complete the first semester at a postsecondary institution with a minimum of twelve hours or the equivalent and a 2.5 grade point average prior to receiving A+ tuition reimbursement.***

** Note: The Missouri Assessment System is currently under review, and that review may result in changes to this requirement.*

North Kansas City Schools provides a process for an attendance or citizenship appeal; contact the A+ Coordinator.

To access the incentive, each A+ eligible student must:

- Make a documented, good faith effort to secure all available federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds that do not require repayment (FAFSA).**
- Male students at 18 years of age must register with the selective service.**

The student financial incentive will be available for a period of four years after high school graduation. To maintain eligibility during that time, each participating student must enroll and attend a Missouri public community college or career-technical school on a full-time basis and maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Signing this agreement in no way obligates the student to participate in the A+ Schools Program. It indicates that the student is aware of the opportunity afforded by this program and will satisfy the written agreement required for those who choose to participate.

Permission is hereby given for the release of A+ Schools Program information, including student records, to the institutions chosen by the student as well as to DESE, as required by law.
