



Alice and Elmer Black Vocational Training Scholarship

2022 Fact Sheet

This scholarship assists students who enroll in and complete a training program, with the desire to learn a useful skill set that will launch them into the workforce and provide a viable income and secure future. Created by Alice and Elmer Black and supported and later managed by an Avondale United Methodist Church committee, the scholarship funds are now part of the North Kansas City Schools Education Foundation and available to district students who plan to pursue vocational training beyond high school.

Eligible areas of vocational training include the construction trades (plumbing, electrical, carpentry and HVAC technician), as well as the culinary arts, cosmetology, automotive technology, agriculture, landscaping, nursing and other certifications. Training must be predominantly hands-on and not exclusively online.

Deadline: Friday, April 1, 2022

Number of Recipients: Two Annually

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000

Eligibility:

- You must be a 2022 graduating senior from one of the district's four high schools: North Kansas City, Oak Park, Staley or Winnetonka.
- You must plan to enroll in a program that leads to "certification" in one of the trades listed in the above description.
- You must have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher during your high school career.

Supporting Documents:

Official Grade Transcript: Please include an official transcript from your high school that shows a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Official Attendance Record: Please include a record of attendance indicating the percentage of days you attended school. If this falls below 90 percent, explain in writing the extenuating circumstances for your absences.

Two Letters of Reference: Letters from teachers, employers or others (no relatives) should provide information the selection committee may use to better understand your character.

- Essay:** Write an essay explaining the career you plan to pursue and why you are applying for this scholarship. On a separate page, include any special circumstances you wish the scholarship committee to consider.
- Selection Process:** Representatives will review the applications and select the winner(s) and a first alternate.
- Payment:** The scholarship will be paid directly to the program you plan to attend (a two-year college, trade school, union apprenticeship, etc.). Funds may be used for classes, tuition, books and student fees. You must complete a minimum of one class/semester. If you withdraw before then, the scholarship funds must be returned to the Education Foundation and the first alternate will receive the funds.
